Lower Plenty Facility

Departing the Kmart carpark at 7.30 am we arrived at Odyssey around 11.30 am and three residents hosted the inspection of facilities, being shown through the crèche, chapel and various therapy and meetings rooms before moving to the family units and then the horticulture and livestock sections on the property.
